Project Assurances: ACD will lead and maintain carp reduction accomplishments during this project's effective life. The ACD will memorialize this commitment in an agreement between the ACD and BWSR, the initial draft of which is attached in eLINK. That agreement references the project feasibility studies (and any future updates) and a Project Maintenance Plan. The Project Maintenance Plan will be prepared by ACD prior to project completion, and approved by ACD after BWSR review.

Additionally, the ACD is requesting that the Sunrise River Watershed Management Organization approve an agreement with ACD to collaborate to maintain the project accomplishments. The ACD shall make management information and progress updates available to BWSR upon request and as part of ACD's annual reporting.

Activity Name: Carp Management

Activity Category: Non-Structural Management Practices

Has Rates and Hours?: Yes

Description: Carp removals and related equipment, tagging, telemetry and surveys throughout the Sunrise River Chain of Lakes with focus on Martin, Typo and Linwood Lakes. Management may expand to Island Lake (between Martin and Linwood Lakes) if data finds this is warranted to meet goals throughout the chain.

Contractors: ACD is selecting contractors. Four contractors will be contacted. Amongst those who respond and who offer the desired services, direct negotiation will occur. Desired services include box netting, seining or other carp removal services, may include radio tagging and tracking, PIT tagging and tracking, population tracking towards goals, and related.

Milestones: Contractor selection in spring 2020. Annual contractor contracts thereafter. Annual carp removals in Martin and Typo Lakes. Two years of carp removals in Linwood Lake. Brief reports in 2021 and 2022 documenting progress toward goals and management recommendations.

Actual Results

2020 - In 2020 the following carp removals occurred: one seine at Linwood Lake, 15 box nettings at Martin Lake. Total carp removed was 746.

2021 - In 2021 the following carp removals occurred: one seine at Linwood Lake, one seine at Martin Lake, 15 box nettings at Typo Lake. Total carp removed was 1,014.

2022 - Setup for spring spawning migration nettings at Linwood and Martin Lakes which were not executed due to not detecting sufficient carp activity. Four box nettings (each with 4 nets) at Typo Lake removing 497 carp. Three box nettings (each with 6 nets) at Martin Lake removing 389 carp.

While the number of carp removed by this grant was below the grant goal, we found that other measures of success were good, particularly water quality improvements similar to those anticipated in the grant application. Such benefits are detailed in the attached Project Maintenance Plan. Also in recognition of catching fewer carp, 19% of the grant was not spent and returned to the State.

Actual Results

2020 - Staff time to coordinate one Linwood Lake seine and three Martin Lake box nettings. Planning for 2021 carp removals.

2021 - Staff time to coordinate one Linwood Lake seine, one Martin Lake seine, and 15 Typo Lake box nettings. Planning for 2022 carp removals.

2022 - The 2022 tech/engineering staff time was paid with non-match, non-grant funds. Work included coordination of spring spawning migration nettings at Linwood and Martin Lakes and box netting at Martin and Typo Lakes using 10 volunteer-baited sites.
